BACKGROUND

Issue one of GO/RT3201 was first published in 1994 and thus a review of this standard was needed to bring up to date the controls mandated within this RGS.

The purpose of this RGS is to detail the supplementary arrangements, which shall be made for the safe working of passenger trains over non-passenger lines. It consists of the high level requirements judged to be the most appropriate in reducing the risks caused by such an operation.

KEY CHANGES INTRODUCED BY THIS RAILWAY GROUP STANDARD

The revision of GO/RT3201 doesn't introduce any new controls to the standard. Changes were made to this RGS to remove duplicated controls. The controls removed are adequately covered by GO/RT3062 - Signallers General Instructions- and are therefore taken out of this RGS to avoid duplication and misunderstanding.

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

Because no new controls are added to the new issue of the standard, there are no special compliance requirements relating to the second issue of this standard. This standard is to be complied with from 2 December 2000.
