BACKGROUND

This document was first issued in April 1999. Since then the Sentinel certification scheme has been introduced, involving the use of plastic cards which it is not practicable for the holder to sign.

Since it is not a safety requirement that the card is signed, issue two removes the last six words of the first bullet point at 6.4.4 (ie “which is signed by the holder”). The change is therefore minor in that it removes the requirement for the holder to sign the card.

KEY CHANGES INTRODUCED BY THIS RAILWAY GROUP STANDARD

The reissue of this standard removes the requirement for a PC, COSS, IWA or DP to sign their current certification card.

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

The change is minor and the compliance date is the same as the issue date of the RGS.

NON COMPLIANCES

The following Non Compliances will no longer apply when this document is introduced:
